Discussion Questions:

1. Do you struggle with the language of God as 'father'?

2. God is love – how a loving God can allow evil is the greatest question facing Christianity. Do you find Bishop Barron's observation that the only mystery greater than the reality of evil is the mystery of goodness helpful?
3. What do you make of the idea of evil being parasitic upon goodness? That evil is simply the lack of goodness in any given situation?
4. What do you make of Andy's argument that if God is spirit and is the pre-existing cause of all that exists today; then if God is love, love logically predates un-love?
5. Do you agree with Harry's assertion that we have a basic moral law ingrained upon our hearts and so each time we appeal to a greater sense of justice we are inadvertently echoing the character of God?
